How to enter the Prize

- 1 Complete this Application Form including all Applicant details.
- 2 Applicants must submit an original Score for an 8 to 10 minute piece for unaccompanied mixed choir to be performed by the Burgundian Consort that must include 4 to 6 voice parts including soprano, alto, tenor and bass (SATB) and no more than one division of any vocal part. The Score must be the original work of the entrant and not copied from any other work and must not have been previously performed in public, recorded for public release or performance or rewarded in a previous composition competition or prize.
- 3 Attach supporting documentation - To be a valid entry, entrants must submit four complete and bound hard copies of their Score along with this **completed application form**. Scores should have the title of the work and the name of the composer only on the front page. Prior to submission to the jury, the front page will then be removed to ensure anonymous consideration.
